### **ADHD: The Facts with an Emphasis in Psychiatry**

#### **Educational Objectives:**

1. To gain a current view of ADHD including dispelling the myths, understanding basic neurobiological correlates and current research.
2. To better understand ADHD subtypes, common comorbidities (including mood and personality disorders) and incidence of the disorder.
3. To gain an understanding of the 'Neuropsychological Perspective', including attention and executive functioning as constructs. Included in this objective will be an emphasis upon the role of psychiatric disorders on cognition, as well as an introduction into how to get properly diagnosed.
4. To gain a greater understanding of the treatment implications for ADHD, including medication interventions and other empirically validated options.
